thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyd unto her ye sd.  
Number of Acres in ye place aforesd, provided it be not already  
taken up, according to ye method of Townships appointed by  
me, and make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office  
Given at Philadelphia ye 12<sup>th</sup> of ye 5<sup>th</sup> Mo. 1683.
