

By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietary and Governor bearing date the fourteenth of the 11th month 1700 to lay out unto Robert Heath 500 acres of Land in Right of Thomas Woolrich There was Survey'd the 27th of the 12^{mo} in the said Robert Heath the Quantity of five hundred acres of land in the Township of Soulberry in the County Bucks Beginning at a Post by the River Delaware at a Corner of Other land of the Said Robert Heath Thence West four hundred and seventy five perches to a post Then by the Great Spring and James Logans Land North west two hundred and ten perches to a post and a Stone Then by Tobias Dymocks land vacant Land East Six hundred and six perches to a black Oak by Then down the several Courses thereof one hundred and forty nine pches to the place of the Beginning
