



By virtue of a Warrt ob1 the Proprietary ob1 to me directed bearing date ye 10th. <sup>11<sup>st</sup></sup>/<sub>mo.</sub> 1702 to execute all Warrts. directed to Phineas Pemberton and not executed And Pursuant to a Warrt from Edward Penington Surveyr. Genrl. to the said Phineas Pemberton to Survey unto Rich Hough 475 acres in Right of his brother John Hough, Surveyed and laid out unto the said Richard Hough in Right of his said brother a Tract of Land in Buckingham township in the County of Bucks Beginning at a heap of Stones four perches from the Societie's line left for a Road. Thence by vacant land N.E. 284 perches to a heap of Stones in the side of a hill. Then by the Proprietaries land N.W. 268 per. to a Post at Daniel Jackson's Corner. Then by the said Jackson's land S.W. 284 per. to a forked black oak. Then by the said Road S.E. 268 per. to the place of beginning. Containing 475 Ac. 2 R. 32 P. Surveyed the 26<sup>th</sup> day of the 3<sup>d</sup> month 1702.
