



By virtue of a warrant from the Comrs. of Property to me directed bearing date the 10th day of the 1st month 1701 to execute all warrants directed to Phineas Pemberton and not executed, And also pursuant to a warrant from Edward Pennington to the said Phineas Pemberton dated the 27th day of the 6th month 1700. Surveyed and Laid out unto Daniel Jackson a Tract of Land in Buckingham Township in the County of Bucks Beginning at a Post in Mary & Alice Hind's line. Thence by Richard Hough's land S. W. 284 per. to a forked black oak. Then N. W. by Land for a Road 282 per. to a Corner marked white oak. Then by widow Musgrove's land N. E. 284 per. to a Post and a heape of stones. Then S. E. by the said Hind's land 282 per. to the beginning. Containing 500 acres and 88 perches, Surveyed the 25th day of the 3^d mo. 1702. By me John Cutler.
