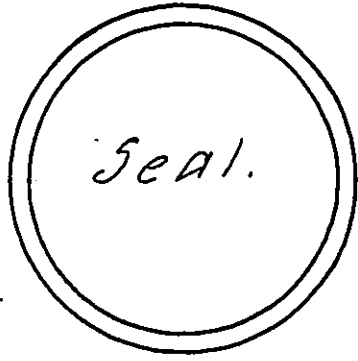


Pensilvania.

Francis Plumsted according to the Method of Townships appointed the Said quantity of Seven hundred & fifty Acres of Land in this Province that has not been already taken up nor is concealed nor Seated by the Indians. and make Returns into the Genl. Surveyor's Office at Philad^a. where this Warrt. is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by the Secretary Given under our hands & the Seal of the Province at Philad^a. 27th. 4^{mo}. 1704.
