

Surveyd and Laid out this 13th. day of June 1719 to James Logan of Philadelphia Merchant a Piece of Land in the Liberties of the City Philadelphia, Beginning at Post in Line of Job Goodson's Land by a Small Run of Water, Dividing this from the ^{sd} ~~Widow~~ ^{Susannah} ~~Widow~~ ^{other} Cassel's, Land Thence by the said Goodson's land South South East Eighty perches to another post Then West South West Six perches. to the said Run.

Then up the same by the Lands of Thomas Masters and the said ^{Susannah} ~~Widow~~ Cassel about ~~to~~ Ninety pches to the place of Beginning Containing four acres, being the proportion belonging the Purchase of Jonathan Stanmore with the Right to which the said James Logan is now Invested Surveyd in Pursuance of a Warrant from the Commissioners Dated October 15th. 1708.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this first day of September 1909 -
