



Pursuant to a Contract of the 1st of Nov^r 1827. with the members of the Board of Property of the State of Pennsylvania & the Authority therein, the Above Tract of land was Surveyed & Calculated by virtue of App^r No 3675 granted by the proprietary government to John Gibson 25th July 1769. Containing three Hundred & thirty two acres Twenty one perch $\frac{8}{10}$ & all^s. Situate in Finley Township Allegheny County.

Note the above Survey includes all the Survey Executed for William Wilson assignee of Sam^l Cook Calling for 343 acs & all^s on a Branch of Racon Creek. Excepting the oblong adj^t Jos Tarrance marked with the letters - W. W.
