Containing three hundred Seven Acres Eighty three Perches & all^s of Six & Ct Situate in Mefflin Township Allegheny County.

N.B. The above Survey is noted by letters as follows.

A Interferes with the Survey James Ridelle of Pitt: in right of Benj: Tate upon location No 3207 dated May 9th 1769 Called Hamilton Hall Survd 26th Nov 1769.

Note in the above Survey States that Said tract was returned to the Land office 8th March 1782 to Wm Bausman Esqr upon Wt of the 4th inst.

B Interferes with the Survey of Geo. Thompson in right of John Earl executed the 26th Nov 1769 Called Liberty Farm in the original draft.
