



A draft of the land described in the location of Robert Allison No 3149 of 24 Augt 1769 Situate in Franklin Township, Fayette County and now returned on S^d Location by virtue of Contract with the Board of Property. Mathew McCoy 48^{as} was patented May 1829 pr Warrant of 15 Mar 1805 the 185^{as} 134^p belongs to John M. Austin Esq^r of Union town. Who claims under an improvement made many years ago it is said by Robert Willis. It is not patented.

To the Board of Property of Pennsylvania F. Lewis D.S. October 1829.

Note. this answers the description of Robt Allison as to Situation &c. but it is said the man who first lived on it was Robert Willis. no survey to be found in either of the names it will depend upon the opinion of the Board whether this shall be accepted or not. the difference in the latter part of The name notes a doubt the name of Allison is not recollected by the early settlers.
