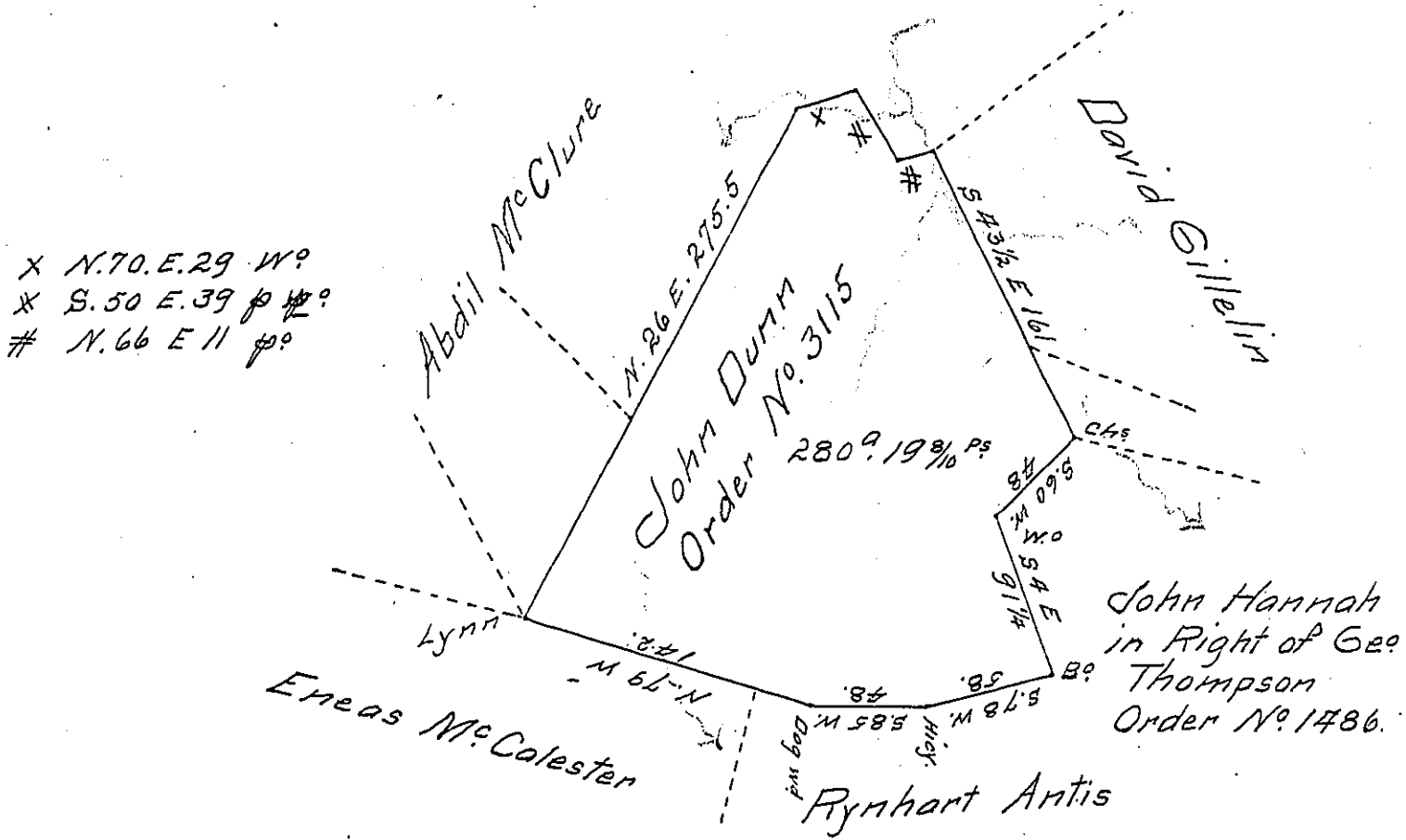


Heirs of Ino Johnston



In Pursuance of a Contract with the Members of the Board of Property of the State of Pennsylvania dated the first day of November 1827 and the authority therein mentioned, the above described Tract of Land was Surveyed & Calculated by virtue of Application No. 3115 granted by the Proprietary Government to John Dunn the 20th of April 1769. Containing two Hundred Eighty Acres, nineteen perches Eight tenth & all^s Situate in Wilkins Township Allegheny County.
