At the Request of Abel Strettell of the Kingdom of Ireland by his Attorney Thomas Hatton that We would Grant him to take up the quantity of four hundred Acres of Land the remainder of five Thousand Acres the Original purchase made of the late Proprietary William Penn Esq. by George Shore of Athlone in the said Kingdom the Right where of being now Vested in the said Abel Strettell — — These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd in Right of the Said purchase and to complete the Same according to ye Method of Townships Appointed the said Quantity of four Hundred Acres of Land which hath not been already Survey'd nor appropriated nor is Seated by ye Indians and make Returns thereof into the Secretarys Office in Order for a further Confirmation. Given under our Hands and the lesser Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 15th day of the 3^d month Anno Domini 1729
