At the Request of John Estough That we would grant him in behalf of William Shardlow a Resurvey on the Lands in this Province which were at first laid out to William Wood and to said William Shardlow jointly in right of their joint Original Purchase of five thousand Acres and afterwards divided by Virtue of a Writ of Partition. These are to Authorize and Require thee to Resurvey or cause to be Resurveyed all the said Lands as well those in the County of Philadelphia as those in the County of Chester ~~which were~~ first Surveys of which have been allow'd which by the Partition were appropriated to the said Shardlow according to the true Lines thereof. And make Returns into the Secretaries Office. Given under our hands and ye Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 17th day of September A. D. 1709.
