At the Request of Isaac Self and John Gye of Market Lavington in the County of Wilts in Great Britain ~~that we~~ by their Anthony Morris that we would Grant them to take up the Lot of Ground within the City of Philad<sup>a</sup> and the Liberty Land in the Liberties thereof belonging to five Hundred Acres of Land purchased by Isaac Self Grandfather to the above said Isaac Self and Edw<sup>d</sup> Gye father of the said John Gye of the Propriet<sup>ys</sup> by Deeds of Lease and Release dated ye 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>d</sup> dayes of ye Month called August 1681 which by Inheritance is Since Descended to the said Isaac and John. These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey and lay out or cause to be Survey'd & laid out unto the said Isaac Self & John Gye the said Lot of Ground in the City of Philadelphia where the <sup>Same</sup> fell by allotment or as near there unto as maybe and the proportion of Liberty Land in the Liberties thereof that has not already <sup>been</sup> taken up nor Survey'd and make Returns thereof into the Secretarys Office in Order for a further Confirmation Given under our Hands & the Seal of the Province at Philad<sup>a</sup> ye 15<sup>th</sup> day of <sup>br</sup> A.D. 1719
