Whereas the Proprietor by his Warrt under his Hand and Provincial Seal bearing date the 2^d of the fifth Month 1683 Directed to the then Surveyor Gen^l Granted to John Spencer Original Purchase of Two hundred and fifty Acres of Land in this Province a certain Lott of Land in right of the said Purchase, to be taken up in the ~~City~~ City Philad^{ia} in ye Third Street from the River Delaware w^{ch} Lott notwithstanding having never hitherto been taken up: These are to Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd to James Spencer Eldest Son of the sd John now deceased a Lott in ye sd City on Delaware Side proportionable to the Purchase aforesd in Some convenient Street where a Vacancy may be found, and make Returns into the Secretaries Office Given under our hands & Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 29th day of Nov^{br} 1707
