N^o 2 Was Surveyed and returned for Alexander McKay^{*} on a ~~Warrant~~ ^{Applⁿ N^o 545} and a patent to the heirs of Richard Jackson Esqr^{dec} Pat^d

N^o 3. Was Surveyed returned on a warrant of September 19th 1785 for Samuel Drummond — 263 — Patented.

N^o 4 was Surveyed for Charles Brookings as patented but the owner does not live in the County and I could not get seeing the draft for the date of the warrant — Geo. or William Thomas^{on Applⁿ N^o 1062 Pat^d} had also owned it.

N^o 5 was warranted to William Shaw bearing date of 28th April 1786 — patented Pat^d

N^o 6 was Surveyed and returned for Barnet Cunningham on order N^o 1909 dated 3rd of April 1769 — patented Pat^d

N^o 7 was Surveyed and returned for John McClelland on a Warrant
