



Situate in Perry township, Union County. Surveyed the 1st day of May 1834. By virtue of an order of Survey granted to Conrad Wagner dated the 27th day of September 1768, No. 5200 Containing one hundred and ninety three acres and one hundred & fourteen perches with the usual allowance &c. The same is (designated by the red lines)

Note. Aaron Levy had a survey made (designated by the green lines) the 8th day of September 1789. In pursuance of a warrent dated the 23d day of January 1789 which includes all Conrad Wagners Survey - and is now owned & occupied by John Richenbach & Jacob Boyer in right of the said Aaron Levy
