



The above is a draft of the land described in the Location of James Smith No. ³³⁹⁰ ~~3390~~ of June 1769. Situate in Dunbar township Fayette County and now returned on S^d Location by virtue of contract with the Board of Property. It is the same land is surveyed to William Collins 19-Febry 1785 pr Warrant of 14th Decr 1784 and is now owned by James Collins and William Patterson living on, and adjoining the premises. Wm Collins Bot of William Harrison who probably owned Smiths Order a Survey appears to have been made as early as 1771 or 1772.
