Note) Michael Stockberger had Locatid at \square in N^o1 made a Small improvement, but was driven of by some ill designing men who also wanted the land - In the lapse of some years he came back and finding some vacant land lower down he settled on it and A. Leasure and some others gave him some more to it. he accordingly took out a warrant for N^o2 as above stated - his Location was however entirely abandoned
