



Surveyed on the 15th of April 1734 to Benjamin Boone a tract of Land Situate in the County of Philad^a being part of four hundred acres laid out to Mouns Jones ^{on y^e 25th of July 1704} by Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietary Dated the 21st day of October 1701 Beginning at a post on the East Side of River Schuylkill a Corner of Marcus Hulings Land thence by the Same North twenty Degrees East four hundred and forty two perches to a post thence by land of John Jones South Seventy degrees East Seventy three perches to a post thence by land of Marcus Hulings South Twenty degrees West four hundred sixty Eight perches to the said River thence up the Same to the place of Beginning Containing two hundred and Seven acres.
