Layed out for Cristen Gleason a tract of land Called wee Kanassitu-
ate and beeing on the west side of Delaware River and next adjoining
to y^e land formerly Surveyed for Mich ffrederik near Dearonink

Begining at a Corner marked white oak of sd frederiks standing
by y^e River side and from thence N N W by sd frederiks line of
marked trees 320 perches to a Corner marked black oak, from thence
W S W 50 perches to a Corner marked white oak, from thence S S E
320 perches by a line of marked trees to a Corner marked spanish
oak standing by sd River side and from thence up by the river
side 54 perches to y^e first mentioned white oak Containing 100 acres
of land
