And is accordingly Entered an<sup>d</sup> obl Recorded in my Office, Philadelphia this 69<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> M<sup>o</sup> Tho Holme Survey Gen<sup>l</sup>obl
