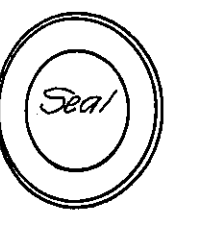


Pensylvania

These are to require thee to survey and lay out to the said Thomas Caras the said Number of four hundred and fifty Acres of Land where not already surveyed nor taken up nor is concealed nor seated by the Indians and make Returns into the Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary ~~and~~ who is to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his Office.

Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the first Month 170 $\frac{1}{2}$  = Edwd. Shippen
