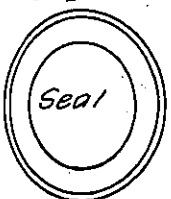

William Penn Proprietary and Govern^r of the Province
of Pennsylvania and Counties annexed.

Whereas Joshua Carpenter hath purchased of the persons to whom
they were laid out or their Assigns all the Right to the High street Lotts
on the South side between the 6th and 7th Streets from the River
Delaware, one small part of a Lott of about twenty eight foot in
breadth only excepted, which he has also requested me to grant
in order to compleat to him the whole square: These therefore
are to require thee forthwith to Survey or cause to be survey'd to y^e sd
Joshua Carpenter the sd vacant part of a Lott within the sd
square in lieu of the like quantity in the same street to be by him
resigned to me and make returns thereof into my Secretaries
Office Given under my hand and Seal at Philad^a the 18th
of 7^{or} 1701. Wm Penn.
