



Surveyed out of Ester Boyers Land unto Samuel Carpenter 25  
 acres of Land Beginning at a corner post fixed by the Creek  
 side called Gunners Creek being a corner of Samuel Carpent-  
 ers Land thence by said Samuel Carpenters Land 232 perches  
 to a tree standing by a small run of water thence East north  
 East 27 perches to a post thence by the said Boyers Land <sup>South 41 degrees East</sup> 190  
 perches to a post thence East 28 1/2 perches <sup>4 1/2 Perches</sup> north to a small creek above  
 the ford that Leads to Boyers house thence down the several  
 courses <sup>of the channel</sup> of the said creek or run of water unto <sup>the</sup> aforesaid Gunners  
 Creek thence <sup>down</sup> the several courses of the said creek to the  
 forsd mentioned post 9<sup>th</sup> day 3<sup>mo</sup> 1698 P.P.
