He paying to the Prop^{rs} use five pounds for the same and one shill⁻ Sterl⁻ quit rent P Ann⁻ for ever. And make Returns into the general Surveyor's Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain & a Copy thereof to be del^{vd} to thee certified by the Secy^s. Given under our hands and y^e Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 12th day of y^e second Month 1703.
