By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietary & Governour
 Dated the 21st day of the Eight Month Anno 1701 -
 There was Surveyd and Laid out the 28th of the fifth Month
 1704 unto Otto Ernest Cock a Tract of Land in the County
 of Philadelphia (being Part of ten thousand acres Laid out
 to Andreas Rudman and Company) Beginning at a
 Corner of Morton's Land by the River Schuylkil:
 Thence by the said Morton's Land North twenty degrees
 East One thousand one hundred and seventy perches
 to a Corner post Thence East south East Sixty eight per-
 ches to a post Then South twenty Degrees West by Rich-
 ard Roads Land One thousand One hundred and
 eighty three perches to the said River Schuylkil Then
 up the same about Eighty perches to the place of Be-
 gin^g Containing five hundred acres
 Returned into the Secretarys Office April 20th 1719.
