Next Ensueing a Certaine front Lot & one Scoolkeel Scituat: within a feild Inclosed by William Boulin being 119 foot: to y^e ~~west~~ ^{south} of y^e said Boulins Lot: being in breadth 20 foot and in Lenth 496 feet: bounded on y^e West with the Said front street and on y^e South with a Reputed vaccant Lot & on y^e East with y^e 2^d Street from Scool-Keel and on y^e North with a Reputed vaccant Lot: With a High Street Lot: Scituat within John Howels feild bounded on the West with y^e Street Befor y^e sd Howels door and on y^e North with back Lots and on y^e East with a Reputed vaccant Lot: on the South with y^e High Street being in breadth 26¹/₂ foot and in Lenth 306 feet and a Certaine Parcel of Liberty Land begining at a Stak being a Corner of a certain peac of Land Laid out for John Boulin: from thence by y^e Said Land and Line of Marked trees West 80 perches to a blak Ok Saplin Marked thence North by a Line of marked trees Marked 32 perches to a stak set in y^e ground by a blak ok Marked thence East by a Line of Marked trees 80 perches to a stak set by another blak ok marked from thence ^{south} by a Line of marked trees South 32 perches to y^e place of begining Containeing 16 acres of Land and is according to y^e bound above described Return'd into y^e Generall Survey^{rs} Office at Philladelphia y^e 30th of y^e 4th mo 1703.
