



William Penn Proprietary & Govern^r of the Province of Pensilvania and Counties annexed.

At the request of Daniel Falkner Agent for the German Purchasers That I would grant him to take up one hundred Acres more of Liberty Land within the bounds of the City of Philad^{ia} being the Remainder of the s^d Land due to the s^d Germans on their purchase of twentyfive thousand Acres These are to require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyd to the s^d Daniel Falkner for the use of ye s^d German Purchasers the s^d Number of one hundred Acres of Land within the s^d Liberties and make Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office. Given under my hand & Seal at Philad^{ia} the 21st of the 8th Moth 1701.
