

Whereas there was a former Peaturne made by me for a certain tract of Land unto Peeter Cok Seni<sup>r</sup> with appears to be Imperfect by Reason of wrong Information of other Lands adjacent which occasioned to Interfere with other mens Lines this I may Certifye that I have made a Reasurvey upon the Said Land with as much Care as possible I Could with the asistanc of them that K knows the Lines adjacent: and have ~~set~~ Surveyed it now as under: beginneing at a Corner white ok Standing in the Line of Thomas Pasgall Land and y<sup>e</sup> Land that was formerly Barnabas Willcoks Land from thence South by a Line of marked trees 145 perches to a ~~Corner~~ Corner marked Spanish ok: being in the Said Pasgalls Land from thence East by a Line of trees marked by the Said Thomas Pasgalls and William Hearnis Land 202 perches to a marked whitt ok Standing 3 perches on the East Sid of y<sup>e</sup> School-Keel mil creek thence north 73 degrees East by a Small Runn 25 perches to a stak Standing on the south Sid of the Said Runn thence north 83 perches to another stak for a Corner thence west 12 perches to a marked blak ok Sapline thence north 55 perches to a Stak ~~whit oak~~ Standing in the Line of John Roads Land thence west by a Line of marked trees 215 perches to the plac of beginneing Containeing and Laid out for two hundred acres of Land Reasurveyed as abovesd the 18<sup>th</sup> of the 12<sup>th</sup> mo. 1699<sup>8</sup>: p<sup>r</sup> me
