order a Lott within the said Cittie according to propor-  
tion. Given under my hand this 10 day of the 12 mo<sup>th</sup>:  
168<sup>4</sup>/<sub>3</sub> being the first year of King James the 2<sup>d</sup>: and  
the fourth of the Govern<sup>r</sup> there
