

In pursuance of the Commiss^{rs} War^t dated the 4th of Oct 1716 for Surveying unto Dan^l fferre 600 acres of land more or Less - Surveyd October y^e 18 1716 to the said Dan^l a Tract of Land on Pecquea Creek in the County of Chester Beginning at a Small Walnut tree at a Corner of Israel Taylor's land Then by the same west by South 217 p. to a post Then by the Lands of Philip fferre and Isaac le ffevre North by west 500 p to a post Thence East by North 197 ~~ches~~ches to a post Then by Harman Richman's land ~~West~~ by South by East 330 p to a hickery tree Then East by North 20 ~~ches~~ches ~~then~~ to a post Then South by East by the said Harman's land 170 ~~ches~~ches to the place of Beginning Containing six hundred acres with allowance of 6 ~~Cent~~ Cent.

Also one hundred (86) acres beginning at a Black oak at a Corner of Rich^d Davis's land Thence by the same South south East 149 p. to a post Then East 108 p. to a Black Oak Then by Jn^o fferre's land North 64 ~~West~~ West 140 p Then West 138 p to the beginning
