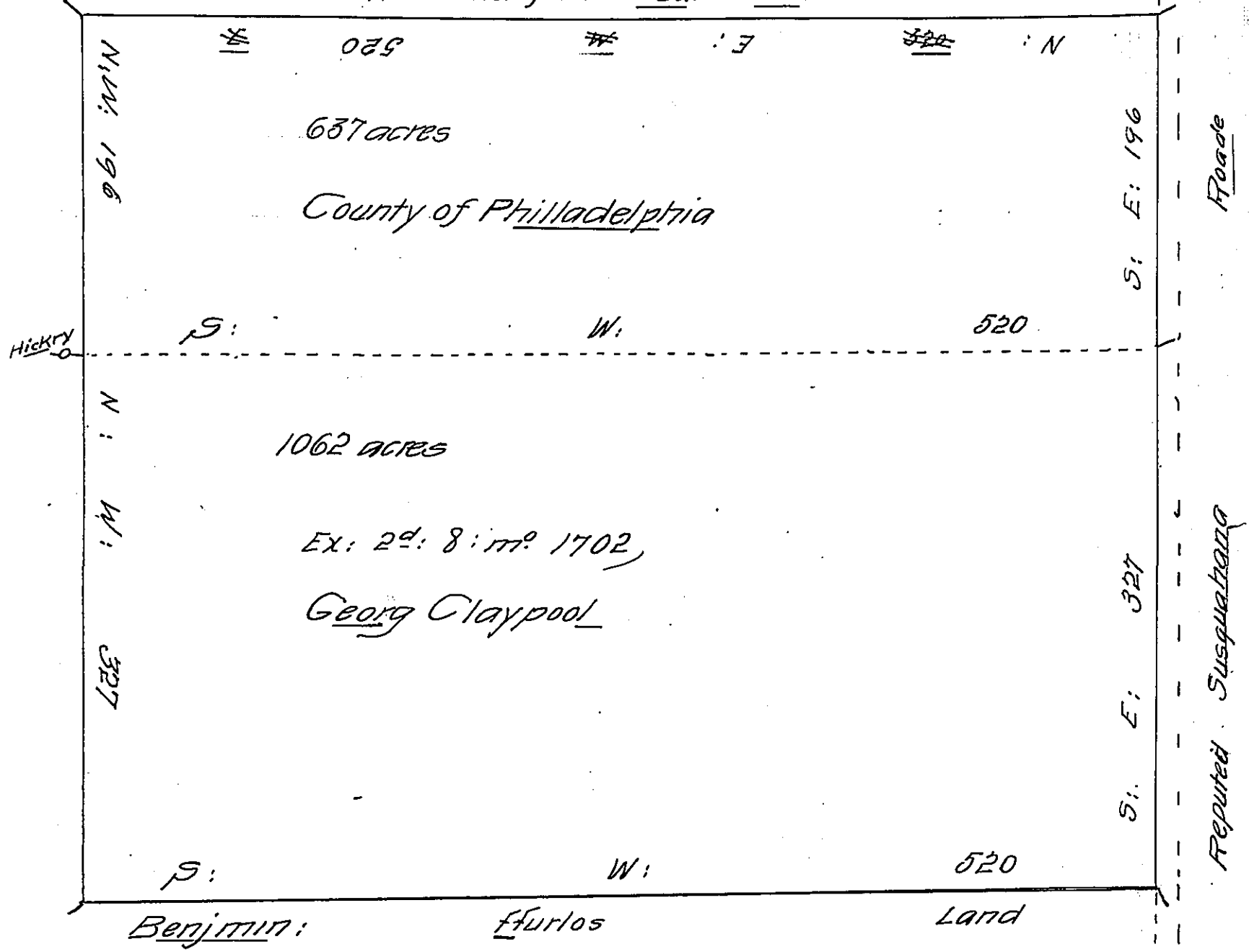


FORM No. 1. William Johns Land from Robert Turnor



Pursuant to a War^t from the Comm^{rs} of prop^{ty} directed unto me Bearing date y^e 29th of y^e 7th mo: 1702 I do Certiefy that I have Reasurvaid a Certaine tract of Land Claimed by George Claypool as by draught produced by hime Joineing the said Land on Robert Turnor^s Land beginneing at a stak being a Corner of the said Turnors ~~land~~ Now William Johns Land from thenc North West by a Line of Marked trees 196 perches to a Corner hickry Marked from thenc South West by a Line of Marked trees 520 perches to y^e Reputed Susquehanna Roade thenc by the said Roade by a Line of Marked trees Sout East 196 perches to a stak set in the ground in the said William Johns Line thenc by the said Line North East 520 perches to y^e plac of beginneing Containeing 637 acres of Land With another tract begining at the y^e said Hickry Marked thenc North West 327 perches to a stak being a Corner of Benjamin furlos: Land thenc by the said furlos Line
