

Pennsylvania S.S. By the Commissioners of Property

At the Request of David Powel of Philadelphia That we would Grant him to take up a lot in Walnut Street at the South East Corner of the Sixth ^{of Philadelphia from Delaware} Street, for which he agrees to pay to the Proprietors use five pounds and the usual yearly quitrent of one Shilling Sterling from the Year 1684 for the same, These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto the said David Powel in the Place aforesaid the 5^d lot of Ground to contain in breadth forty nine foot and half and Two Hundred fifty five feet deep ^{on ye 5^d Sixth Street} provided the same be clear of all other Surveys and Lawfull claims and make a Return thereof into the Secretarys Office which Survey in case the said David Powel fulfill the above agreement within three months after the date hereof shall be valid otherwise the same is to be void as if it had never been made nor this Warr^t ever granted, Given under our hands and Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 26th day of ye 7th month Ann^o Dⁿⁱ 1715
