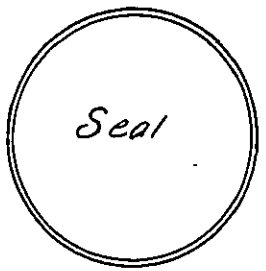


Pennsylvania

At the Request of Nathan^L Puckle Attorney to Thomas Mayleigh of London, That we would Grant him a Resurvey on the Lotts and Liberty Land appurtenant to ~~the~~ an Original Purchase of Fifteen Hundred Acres made by Rob^t Greenaway to W^{ch} 5^d Purchase ~~and~~ with the Appurtenances, the Said Thomas Mayleigh now claims the the whole Right, These are to Authorize and Require thee forthwith to Resurvey the said Lotts being one in the front Street ^{of Philad^{ia}} on Delaware of thirty foot in breadth and one in the High Street of thirty nine foot where they Originally fell in ye first Location of ye sd City or have since been appropriated to ye sd Purchase together with his proportion in ye Liberties of the Said City and make Returns into the Gen^L Surveyors Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee Certified by the Secretary.
