

Whereas a Certain Tract of Land in the County of Philadelphia bounded Northeast with the land of James Steel Northwest with Christian Myers's land & Southwest with Isaac Clines land South East with Clause Johnsons Land formerly layd out and Surveyd for David Powell in part of his Purchase Granted him by the Comiss^r Warrant dated ye 10th of Sep^r 1787.

Which Land hath afterwards been Surreptitiously Surveyd by Henry Penypacker for his owne use, I doce therefore hereby Enter a Caveat in the Surveyor Gen^l's Office against Granting any Return of Said to the Said Henry Penypacker or any other in Order to Confirm ^{it} ~~Said~~ Land until I am first Satisfyed Concerning the Same Dated ye 21th of ye 6^m 1725.
