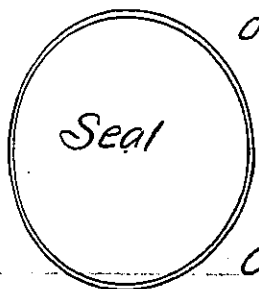

William Penn Absolute Proprietary and Govern^r in Chief
of the Province of Pennsylvania and Territories y^unto
belong^{ing}

At the Request of George Pierce for himself and William
Watson, That I would grant them in right of John Jones and
Michael Jones of Bristol Purchasers of One Thousand Acres
to take up their Proportion of Land within the Liberties of the City
Philadelphia to their Said Purchase belonging;

These are to will and require thee forthwith to Survey or cause to be
Survey'd unto them twenty Acres of Land within the Said Liberties
not already taken up - They Settling and improving the same

according to Regulation, And make Returns thereof into my
Secretaries Office, Given under my hand and Seal at
Philadelphia the fifteenth Day of the Sixth Month 1700
