Surveyor general dated the 13 day of the 11th month 1700 Laid out
and resurveyed onto William Biles one tract of Land in the
County of Bucks formerly Laid out to Christopher Bennet
beginning at Spanish Oak in the line of Lawrence Pearson Land
then North West ~~by~~ by west one hundred thirty six perches to a post
then by Land of the said Wm Biles north 34 grs E one hundred
~~thirty five perches~~ ^{to a red oak} then by the sd Biles Land S.E. by E. One
hundred and forty perches to a red oak. Then by the Said Biles
Land South thirty seven degrs W. one hundred thirty five perches
to the place of Beginning Containing one hundred and eighteen
acres Resurveyed and Certified under my hand the 20th day of
the 2nd month 1701 p
