



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Commrs to me directed bearing date the 10th day of the fifth month 1702 to Resurvey all the Lands in Bristol and Falls Townships in the County of Bucks, Resurveyed unto John Burgess a Tract of Land in Bristol Township in the Said County, purchased from Laurence Pearson Beginning at a Post in William Biles line. Thence by the Same S.E. by E. 1 deg^s E. 180 perches to a Spanish Oak in a great Swamp, Then by The Mannor land S.W. by W. 142 perches to a Wallnut tree in a Meadow, Then by Phineas Pemberton's land N.W. by W. 1 deg^s W. 191 perches to a Post. Then by Anthony Burton's land E. 30 deg^s N. 144. perches to the first mentioned Post being the place of beginning Containing 146 Acres. Resurveyed the 26th day of the 11th month 1702
