Resurveyed the 14th day of the 11th month 1701 by virtue of a War-
rant from the Governour dated the first day of the first month
170^o unto William Derrick one hundred and forty Eight Acres
neare Rights Town in the County of Bucks. Beginning at a
Corner marked White Oake at William Parlets Corner, thence by
William Parlets land One hundred and Ninety Two perches to
a Corner marked Hickery North West, Then South West One -
hundred and twenty four perches to a Corner marked black Oake,
Then South East One hundred and Ninety two perches to a Corner
Post, Then North East One hundred and Twenty four perches to
the place of beginning Certified under my hand.
