



By virtue of a Warrant from Jacob Taylor Surveyor Genl of the Province of Pennsylvania & Territories to me directed bearing date the 29th 3^{mo} 1707 Surveyed and Laid out unto Thomas Cam (Original Purchaser of 500 acres) a tract of Land in Hilton Township in Bucks County Beginning at a Post in Coll' Mildmays Line at the Corner of Jeremiah Langhorns tract, Thence by the S^d Langhorns Land North West 320 perches to a Hickory tree, Then N: E: by Vacant Land 250 perches to a Hickory tree, Then by Vacant Land S: E: 320 perches to an Ash tree in the S^d Mildmays line Then by the S^d Line S: W: 250 perches to the place of beginning Containing five hundred Acres, Given under my hand the 3^d 4th 1707.
