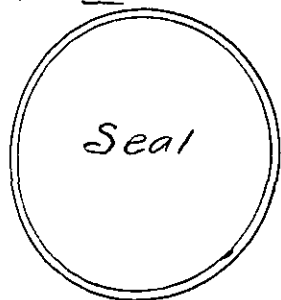


Pennsylvania S.S.



By the Commissioners of Property

At the Request of William Blackfan the Proprietors Kinsman that We would grant him to take up within the Mannor of Highlands in the County of Bucks the quantity of Two hundred Acres of Land for which he agrees to pay to the Said Proprietrs use fforty Pounds <sup>Money of Pennsylvania</sup> for the whole and the yearly quitrent of one shilling Sterling for each Hundred Acres. These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or Cause to be Surveyd unto the Said William Blackfan in ye Said Mannor in one ~~Entire~~ Regular piece and with as little Injury to the remainder thereof as maybe. The Said quantity of Two hundred acres of Land that has not been Surveyed to any other person and make Returns thereof into the Secretarys Office which Survey in case the Said William Blackfan fulfill the above agreement within two years after ye date hereof shall be Valid otherwise the Same is to be void as if it had never been made nor this Warrant ever granted. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 30<sup>th</sup> day of 7br anno Din 1718
