

Pursuant to a Warrant under the hands of the Commiss<sup>rs</sup> of Property and the Seal of the Province bearing date the 10<sup>th</sup> of the first month 170 $\frac{1}{2}$  Granting (at the Request of Gabriel Beans) four hundred and fifty acres of Land to be Surveyd and laid out unto Thomas Caras in Right of his ffather William Caras purchaser of ye<sup>sd</sup> quantity There is Surveyd and laid out unto Thomas Caras a Tract of Land in Soulbury Township in County of Bucks beginning at a post by a ~~white~~ black oak being a Corner of Jedidiah Allen's Land from thence by the said Land Northeast three hundred and twenty perches to a post near a Spanish Oak on one side and a white oak on the other side marked T.C. From thence by vacant Land North West two hundred twenty five perches to a post by a great Maple tree in a Run, from thence by Blackshaw's Land South West three hundred and twenty perches to a post. Then by the side of a Road South east two hundred twenty five perches to the place of Beginning Containing four hundred and fifty acres, Surveyd by John Cutler the 27<sup>th</sup> of the 3<sup>d</sup> Month 1702.
