

Pursuant to a Warrant under the hands of the Commissioners
of Property and the Seal of the province bearing date the 19th
day of the third month 1702 Granting two hundred acres of Land
to be Survey'd and laid out unto Ezra Crosdale by him purchas-
ed of the heirs of William Bennet being the Remainder of
the Said Bennet's purchase of One thousand acres.
There is Survey'd and laid out unto Ezra Crosdale a Tract
of land Souliberry Township in the County of Bucks Beginning
at a post at Samuel Beaks's Corner from thence by the line
of Thomas Garuss's land North west one hundred perches to a
great white oak from thence north east by vacant land three
hundred and twenty perches to a small white oak,
from thence by vacant land south east one hundred perches
to a post by a forked black oak then by the said Samuel
Beaks's land South West three hundred and twenty perches to
the place of Beginning, Containing Two hundred acres,
Survey'd by Jno Cutler the 15th day of 8 br 1702.
