At the Request of Samuel Carpenter That we would grant him a Resurvey on one Tract of Land in Bristol Township in the County of Bucks laid out and Confirmed by the Comrs Patent for two hundred acres to John Otter and by him Conveyed to the Said Samuel, also another parcel of thirty three acres in the Said Township twenty five acres pcell Whereof were laid out to Francis and Michael Rossell and three acres pchased by Rossell of Samuel Clift and ye remaining five acres pchased by the Sd Carpenter of Thomas Brock who therewith also released ye aforesaid three acres also on a small Lott of Sixty three foot Joyning on the Mill purchased of John Town, Also on three Acres and a half or thereabouts in the Said Township purchased of Peter White, all the Said Lands lying Contiguous or near to each other These are to Require thee to Resurvey or cause to be Resurveyed faithfully all the Severall pcells aforesaid in one Tract if they be found Contiguous or if not as near in one as may be according to the true Outlines and bounds of the most Authentick Survey & make Returns thereof into the Surveyors Office at Phila where this Warrt is to Remain and a Copy to be transmitted to thee by the Secretary who is also to take thy returns into his office Given under our hands and Seal of the Province at Phila the 21st of ye 11th mo 1705. 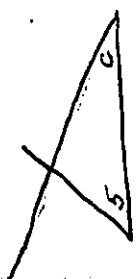
