



by Vertue of a warrant from Edward Penington Surveyr Genll directed unto me bearing ^{date} ye 29th of ye 6^m 1700: I hereby Certiefy into his office that I have Surveyd and Laid out ye 2d of ye 8th m^o Ensueing unto George Peere and William Wattson a certain peec of Land in ye City Liberty beginneing at a Stak Sett in ye ground in the Line of Edward Penington & Companys Land and by the Said Line of marked trees East North East Ninety three prches to another Stak neere the Corner of William Powells Land from thence North by a Line of marked trees thirty Seven and a half perch to another Stak Sett in the ground ^{ninety three perches} from thence West South West by a Line of marked trees ^{ninety three perches} to a fourth Stak Sett up in ye Line of John Balls Settm't and by the Said Line of marked trees South thirty Seven and a half prch to ye plac^e of begining Containeing and Laid out for twenty acres of Land
