These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey and lay out to the Joseph Paul the Lott aforesaid as formerly Surveyd or as near the place where by the Original Location of the City it was placed, as may be, And make Returns into the general Surveyor's Office at Philadelphia where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary,
