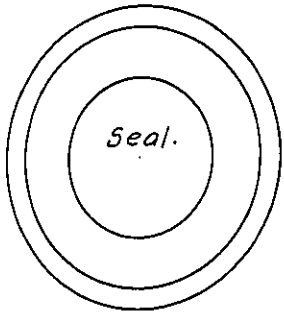


Pensilvania.



By the Commissioners of Property.

At the Request of Moses Musgrove That we would grant him to take up three hundred Acres of Vacant Land where not already Survey'd or taken up for which he has Agreed to pay to the Proprietors Use a fee, y^e Rate of Ten pounds & hundred part thereof in Land and the rest in Nine Months with half a year's Interest for the Same. These are to Authorize thee to Survey and lay out to the said Moses the said quantity of three hundred Acres of such Land in the County of Chester as aforesaid and such as is not seated by y^e Indians and make Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office which Survey in case the sd Moses fulfill the agreem^t afores^d shall be Valid otherwise the same shall be void and of no other effect than as if y^e same had never been made nor this warr^t ever Granted. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 22^d of y^e 5th month A.D. 1713.
