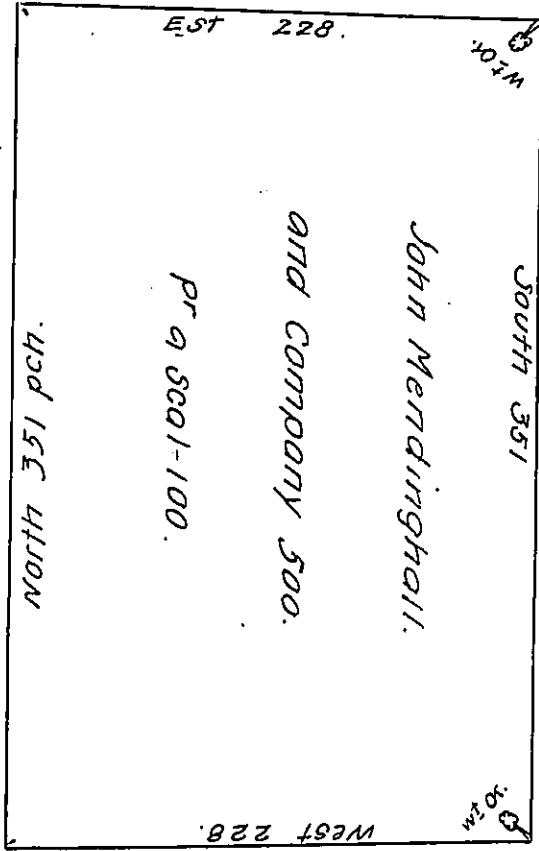

By vertu of A warrant to me directed bearing date ye 28, ^{mo}/₇, 1700. I have surveyed for John Mendinghall and Company A tract of Land scituat on the South Side Brandywin Creek begining at a corner tree of the Govt Land then by a line Est. 228 perchs. to A bound post of Joseph pennocks Land then by his line south 351 prh. thence west 228 prh. to A bounded white oak standing in ye Govts Line thence North 351 prh. to the place of begining Containing 500 Acres of Land the 24 ^{mo}/₁₀, 1700.
