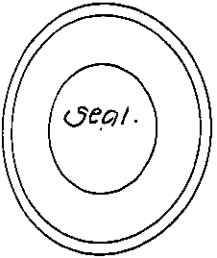


Pensilvania ss:

retaries Office. Given under our hands and Seal of the Province at Philad^a the
tenth day of the second Month (April) in the Sixth Year of the Reign of our
Sovereign Anne of England &c. Queen Annoy Dom. 1707.
