surveyd and Laid out the sixth Day of the third month 1718, unto John Woolf Miller a certain Tract of Land on the Westside of Schuylkil Beginning at a white oak by the side of the said River at a corner of Thomas Millard's Land and running by the said Millards Land South West two hundred seventy six perches to a corner post Then South East by a Line of Marked trees one hundred perches to a corner post Then North East by Andrew Suckler's Land three hundred and thirty perches to the said Schuylkil River Then up the several courses thereof to the place of Beginning Containing one hundred seventy five acres.

This Land ^{is} in part of five hundred acres - mentioned (to be Surveyd to Hance George Schutz and Matth. Ringer) in a warr dated the 20th of the Eleventh month 1718 the above mentioned parcel of one hundred seventy five acres being by consent of Parties Surveyd to the said John Woolf Miller.

Returned into the Secretary's Office the 21st 4^{mo} 1718.
